REMOTE LEARNING UPDATE

We hope this letter finds you and your family well. By now all children should be accessing their remote learning either online through Google Classroom or Tapestry or working through a learning pack. Set out below are a few frequently asked questions that parents and carers have been asking. We hope you find it useful.

Q1. I am unable to login to Google Classroom (GC) on my phone or my tablet.

If you are using a phone or tablet, please download the app first, which you can get from the App Store.

Q2. I do not have login details for the live sessions.

Once your child is in GC they just click on the link at the top of the class page at the correct time. Timings can be found on the school website:

For children in nursery and reception the zoom logins are the same each day so please make a note of it or contact the school if you have lost this information.

Q3. My child's username and login does not work.

Please check that you are using lower and upper case letters correctly.

For GC make sure that you have included **.309** after your child's name.

Q4. My child has finished her learning pack. Will it be marked?

Packs can now be returned to the school for marking.

Q6. We find it difficult to complete the work in the Google document. Is there another way?

Yes. Work can be completed on paper; a photograph can be taken and sent in to the teacher.

Q7. Does my child have to engage with remote learning?

Yes. Schools are required to set remote learning for pupils during lockdown and it is a statutory requirement; therefore pupils should be learning during term time. School will be in contact if children are not completing tasks. We want all our children to make the most of their opportunities during this time and not fall behind.

Q8. We do not have very many books at home and I want my child to take part in Bruce Grove Reading Challenge. What can I do?
