English

Spelling and handwriting

Children will learn how to use their phonics skills to spell different words including all year one common words—a list will go home each week as part of the homework.

Reading and writing

Children will read and write different genres of writing. They will learn how to write simple/ interesting sentences using correct punctuation, e.g. using capital letters, full stops, exclamation, marks, question marks and commas.

Maths

Mental methods for adding and subtracting.

Learning number bonds /multiplication facts.

Place value— counting and ordering 20 and beyond.

Describe 2D /3D shapes and their

Science

In Science we will be exploring everyday materials and their properties and predicting which objects sink or swim.

We will be building different types of structures for specific purposes.

History: Homes Now and in the Past

We will learn about some of the differences between old and new homes and discuss historic buildings that can be found in the local area.

Geography: Map Making

We will learn that maps and plans are representations of space in two dimensions and flat images. We will also learn to describe the location using simple compass directions.

Art /Design and Technology

We will be learning about primary and secondary colours, colour mixing techniques, and applying these skills in painting and printing

In DT we will be learning to describe fruits and vegetables and explain how to identify fruits. We will develop food preparation skills with an increased focus on taste testing and ingredient choices.

Religious Education

We will introduce Judaism and find out what Jewish people believe about God and the covenant.

Music

We are learning to sing songs in small groups, and explore pulse, rhythm, pitch and dynamics.

We are also learning to listen to and appraise a range of songs.

PSHE: Health and Relationships

Our topics are Families and committed relationships, Coping with change and Healthy Body Healthy Minds.

Computing

Digital Writing—children will develop their keyboard skills and learn about useful tools in writing programs.

Programming—children will learn to program an animation using Scratch Junior.

PE

Athletics and Net and Wall Games —We will be developing a range of skills in athletics including running, jumping and throwing.
