After School Boosters	£4000	
Speech and Language Therapist	£11,800	Onsite weekly speech and language therapist who has oversight of the school's caseload and works closely with the SENCo and school's speech and language officer. The officer provides individual support for pupils. Pupils are more engaged in lessons, communicating more and accessing the curriculum through the pre teaching of key vocabulary. Improved social skills and confidence observed which impacts on their engagement and interaction with peers and adults.
Good Attendance Incentives	£1500	The persistent absence rate has reduced from 22.13% to 18.45% but remains above the national average
Club Subsidy	£7000	There is an increased uptake of after school clubs, with more pupils participating.
Immersion Catch up groups for language acquisition	£12,000	Y1-6 100% made expected progress These groups are new to the English language so would not be working at age related expectations in reading and writing but have made good progress.
Additional communication and language development in the Early Years	£15,000	100% PP group made expected progress and are on track for speaking and listening.
Y2 Phonics Catch Up Group	£2060	97% of the group passed the re-takes
Accelerated Reader Library administration and resources	£6000	Pupils report that they enjoy Accelerated Reader and it helps them to read more. Lunchtime and after school clubs are well attended by pupils and parents.
Counselling and Art therapy /Nurture group	£12,000	Staff have reported that pupils are more settled in class and able to access learning more readily. Lunchtime and behaviour incidents have reduced by 80%. Y2 PP group: 100% made the expected progress in reading, writing and maths

Writing Groups Y2-6	£19,000	To accelerate progress in writing in a small group setting.
Maths Booster	£8000	To support Year 2 and 6 pupils
One to one reading Y1-6	£42,000	All class teaching assistants are assigned pupils to read with 3/4 times a week, ensuring that pupils are 'heard' by another adult.
Code X group reading	£18,000	A small group reading acceleration programme for PP pupils working just below threshold.
Speech and Language Therapist	£11,800	To give specialist support for pupils experiencing difficulties with speech
Good Attendance incentives	£1500	To fund an outing for the best class attendance at the end of term
Club Subsidy	£7,000	To provide access to enrichment programmes that some pupils may not have access to
Immersion Catch up groups for language acquisition	£12,000	To support new arrivals with the acquisition of functional language and phonics.
Additional communication and language development in the Early Years	£15,000	To support pupils in the EYFS who have been identified as requiring additional intervention with speech.
Y2 Phonics Catch Up Group	£2060	To ensure that pupils meet the standard in the Y2 retakes.
Accelerated Reader Library administration and resources	£6000	To maintain and stock our well attended lunchtime and after school club and to ensure everyone is reading including our PP group.
Counselling and Art therapy	£16,000	For pupils to have a safe space to develop resilience and coping strategies; enabling them to become more ready to learn and engage with school life.
